Governor Reynolds has specified in her newest proclamation that each winter sport athlete will have two spectators. Below are West Bend-Mallard's plans to uphold this proclamation.

WBM COVID Winter Sports Rules

1. Each athlete will have two color coded, leveled passes for their spectators with the athlete's name on the back. These passes must be presented to the ticket takers upon entering. The ticket takers will be checking off the athlete's name on the roster as you present your passes. These passes do not cover payment for the game. For example: WBM JV girls passes will be neon green.
2. Spectators will not be permitted to come early and will be expected to leave after their game is finished. For example: a spectator with only a JV boys game pass will not be able to attend the JV girls game or any varsity games. Spectators may be asked to wait in the lobby area, concession stand area, or out in their car until the game ends and fans exit the gym for the next game.
3. WBM will clear out the gym between each game for the home and visitor spectators. Passes will be checked by administration at this time and anyone without a pass will be asked to leave. Spectators may stay in the gym if they also possess a pass for a later game. Examples: spectators with a JV girls pass and a Varsity boys pass may remain in the gym for all games. Spectators with a JV girls pass, and a varsity girls pass may stay for the JV boys game but will have to leave before the varsity boys game begins. Passes must be presented to the administration checking between games when the gym is cleared.
4. These color coded, leveled passes must be kept and reused for all home and away games. If these passes are lost, a \$20 replacement fee will be charged.
5. Masks will be required by all fans. No exceptions. If you cannot wear a mask, we ask that you stay at home and watch our livestream feed on our Facebook page or website.
6. WBM will be offering a concession stand, but we ask that you diligently keep your mask on for everyone's safety as much as possible while you eat.
7. All spectators will be expected to sit in groups of two, physically distanced from others. WBM will have the bleachers marked where fans can sit.
8. Please be kind to the event workers. These are not their rules. If you have an issue, please ask to speak with an administrator.
